Needs Identified to Date

- More enforcement staffing
- More education
- More signage need to find locations for signs
- Prioritize, maintain and surface roads (need to distinguish between main trails and roads for OHV)
- Provide Great American Outdoors Act Phase II input for funding allocations (when input period opens)
- Common-sense information about rules on dirt roads
- Trash disposal information to users
- Dust abatement/mitigation



Opportunities/Resources Identified to Date

- CERT/Woods Watch Expand and or use model for recreation watch group
- Road kill assessment by livestock officers when livestock are hit
- AOT #AppreciateAZ messaging campaign materials and webinars available to all
- AZ State Parks Grants (signs, law enforcement, small and large scale projects, emergency funds)
- OHV dealership education packages from AZ State Parks
- OHV Ambassador as online vessel for messages and updates to OHV clubs/users
- "Places to Ride" map, once updated

- Provide input for \$ allocations during Phase II of the Great American Outdoors Act, once available
- Coordinate with USFS and NFF to develop Geofencing, focus group
 - Look into opportunities with existing apps like OnX, OnX Off Road and/or Dyrt
- NFF Matching Awards Program for on-the-ground projects
- NFF Strike Teams Use as model for local recreation related efforts
